**Pest Control Technician**

**Description of Duties**

Provides specialized pest and vegetation control on all Port facilities using measures within established guidelines and approved procedures. Conducts inspections to detect the existence of pests (rodents, insects, etc.) and takes action to ensure all Port facilities remain essentially pest free. Maintains the vegetation control around the perimeters of piers and wharves right-of-way by applying herbicides.

**Minimum Qualifications**

Must have a State of Texas Certified Pest Control Applicator license with a minimum of three years (3) related experience. A thorough knowledge of standards of pest control guidelines relative to environmental controls and a familiarity with waterfront environment. A flexible work schedule including weekends. A valid Texas Drivers License is required with a good driving record. Must be able to obtain a TWIC card.
