Description of Duties

Repairs and rebuilds piers, including bull rails, tie bits, and bumpers. Cleans sheds, blows off pallets, picks up trash, cuts grass, repairs roadways, repairs roofs, repairs post in sheds, repairs doors, and moves a variety of items. Uses acetylene torch for burning and cutting. Constructs forms, replaces rebar, pours and finishes concrete. Drives fork lift, dump truck, flatbed truck and trash truck. Operates a chain saw, jack hammer, electric and air drills and grass cutting equipment. Ensures that tools are maintained in good working order. Assists other trades workers.
