ACCESS TO GALVESTON CRUISE TERMINAL REDIRECTED

Galveston, Texas...October 12, 2001...Repairs are being made to Harborside Drive bridge, the direct route to The Texas Cruise Ship Terminal on Galveston Island resulting in new interim directions for passengers cruising from Galveston Island. Construction on Harborside Drive bridge is scheduled to begin on Thursday, October 18, 2001 and last for about a month.

The new access to Galveston's cruise ship terminal is as follows:

Travel south on I-45 to Galveston Island via the Galveston Causeway.

- Proceed across Causeway.
- I-45 becomes Broadway, Galveston's main thoroughfare.
- Continue 4.4 miles through traffic light at 59th Street and proceed through traffic light at 53rd Street.
- Traveling in the inside lane on Broadway, prepare to turn left (north) at traffic light at 51st Street.
- Proceed 4/10 of a mile on 51st Street to top of overpass.
- At top of overpass, turn right (east) on to Harborside Drive, proceed 2.1 miles to Kempner Avenue also known as 22nd Street, going through three (3) traffic lights.
- At Kempner (22nd), turn left (north). Cruise Terminal will be directly ahead.

Directional signs will be posted at major intersections on Broadway and on the overpass at 51st and Harborside. Orange traffic cones will be placed beginning at 29th and Harborside to provide additional assistance.
