

SPECIALIZED RAIL CARS

The Union Pacific Railroad is experimenting with a new type of transportation vehicle to move roll-on, roll-off cargo from the Port of Galveston.

Specialized cars to handle vehicles at Wallenius Wilhelmsen Terminal are being tested to move Caterpillar equipment from the facility at Pier 37 to dealerships in the mid-western part of the United States.

The enclosed rail cars will provide a secure mode of transportation to move the cargo to the final destination.

P&O Ports was the stevedore in charge of the loading operation.
