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Under Development

- 1) The parking lot operated by the Port of Galveston at 29th street is under construction and is being expanded to consolidate the Port's parking operations.
- 2) The Port is investing \$7 million to expand and provide enhancements to Cruise Terminal No. 2 located at Pier 27. Certificates of Obligation were sold to fund this redevelopment and will be paid back through revenues from cruise operations.
- 3) The headquarters for the Port of Galveston Police Department will be relocated, Cruise Terminal No. 2 will be expanded westward, ADM/Farmland will be reconfigured, and a new park will be built on the site where Grain Elevator B once stood. The police headquarters will be funded through grant funds from the federal government. The demolition of the elevator and the cruise terminal expansion will be funded through bonds, repaid from revenues from cruise operations.
- 4) A roll-on, roll-off terminal is being developed at Pier 34 for Wallenius Wilhelmsen Lines. The concrete rubble from the demolition of Elevator B will be used to fill the eight acre site.
- 5) A portion of Pier 35 will be demolished to allow for the development of the Wallenius Wilhelmsen roll-on, roll-off terminal at Pier 34.
- 6) Mandates from the federal government require ports to implement new security measurements. Under the Port Security Grant program managed by the Transportation Security Administration, the Port of Galveston received funds to make security improvements. A new security complex and related fencing is being installed in the west end of the port from these Round One grant awards.
